Alternative COVID-19 Vaccine Sites

Pillars Community Health is building its capacity to be able to administer the vaccine, in partnership with Cook County Department of Public Health. Cook County has entered Phase 1B, but there are not enough vaccines to go around. We do not have capacity to take phone calls or voicemails inquiring about vaccine availability. When vaccines become available, we will post information to our website at www.PillarsCommunityHealth.org. In the meantime, consider reaching out to one of these alternative locations.

SPRINGFIELD – The State of Illinois is now partnering with Hy-Vee pharmacies across central and northern Illinois to offer COVID-19 vaccinations to eligible individuals. Hy-Vee has 16 locations in Bloomington, Canton, Galesburg, Hamilton, Milan, Moline, Macomb, Peoria, Peru, Rock Island, Silvis, Springfield, and Sycamore and estimates being able to provide up to 200 vaccinations each day.

COOK COUNTY - The State of Illinois is also partnering with [Walgreens](#) and [Jewel-Osco](#) pharmacies to provide COVID-19 vaccinations. A total of 92 Walgreens locations and 92 Jewel-Osco locations have been added to the coronavirus.illinois.gov website, where you can find links to schedule an appointment.

More than 3.2 million Illinoisans are eligible for COVID-19 vaccination in [Phase 1B](#). Eligible residents are also able to receive a vaccine at one of the Illinois National Guard (ILNG) assisted and Cook County Health sites. Appointments can be scheduled at vaccine.cookcountyil.gov. Another five state supported sites are scheduled to open in the coming weeks and larger vaccination locations across the state are in development.

Since February 4, 2021, 134 new locations have been added to the list of COVID-19 vaccination sites open to the public for a current total of 517 locations. The new sites include 22 local health department, medical center, and hospital locations, two new mass vaccination locations supported by the local health department and Illinois National Guard, and 110 additional retail pharmacy stores.

There are now more than 850 vaccination locations in Illinois open to the public. The new sites include 339 Walgreens stores throughout Illinois, which will be receiving vaccine out of a federal allocation and not from the state's allotment. The State of Illinois is partnering with CVS, Hy-Vee, Jewel-Osco, Kroger, Mariano's, Meijer, Walgreens, and Walmart pharmacies to provide COVID-19 vaccinations.

The current phase of vaccination, Phase 1B, includes approximately 3.2 million people in Illinois. While we are working to increase the number of vaccines administered daily, we are limited by the amount of vaccine available and allocated by the federal government. Vaccinations are available only by appointment at this time and we encourage people to check back frequently for open appointments. Until the supply is increased, there will be a great demand and we ask people to be patient. Individuals should be signing up for an appointment to receive their second dose while they are getting their first vaccination.

Locales Alternativos para Obtener la Vacuna contra COVID-19

Pillars Community Health está trabajando para incrementar su capacidad para administrar la vacuna contra COVID-19, en colaboración con el Departamento de Salud del condado de Cook. El condado de Cook ha entrado a la Fase 1B, pero no hay suficientes vacunas. No contamos con la capacidad para responder a llamadas o mensajes referentes a la disponibilidad de la vacuna. Cuando las vacunas estén disponibles pondremos la información en nuestro sitio de internet en www.PillarsCommunityHealth.org. Por el momento, puedes ponerte en contacto con alguno de estos sitios.

SPRINGFIELD – El Estado de Illinois se ha asociado con las farmacias Hy-Vee en la región central y del norte de Illinois para ofrecer vacunas contra COVID-19 a individuos elegibles. Hy-Vee cuenta con 16 locales en Bloomington, Canton, Galesburg, Hamilton, Milan, Moline, Macomb, Peoria, Peru, Rock Island, Silvis, Springfield y Sycamore, y estiman que pueden proveer hasta 200 vacunas por día.

CONDADO DE COOK/COOK COUNTY – El Estado de Illinois también se ha asociado con las farmacias de [Walgreens](#) y [Jewel-Osco](#) para ofrecer vacunas contra el COVID-19. Un total de 92 farmacias Walgreens y 92 locales de Jewel-Osco han sido añadidos al sitio de internet coronavirus.illinois.gov, donde puedes encontrar enlaces para hacer una cita. Más de 3.2 millones de personas en Illinois son elegibles para recibir la vacuna contra el COVID-19 en la Fase 1B ([Phase 1B](#)). Las personas elegibles también pueden recibir la vacuna en los sitios asistidos por Guardia Nacional del Estado de Illinois (Illinois National Guard) y los sitios del departamento de salud de Cook County. Las citas pueden programarse en vaccine.cookcountyil.gov. Illinois cuenta con 850 locales de vacunación abiertos al público. La fase de vacunación actual, Fase 1B, incluye aproximadamente 3.2 millones de personas en Illinois. Estamos trabajando para incrementar el número de vacunas administradas diariamente, sin embargo, estamos limitados por el número de vacunas disponibles y suministradas por el gobierno federal. Las vacunas únicamente están disponibles con cita previa en este momento, y recomendamos que las personas revisen frecuentemente para encontrar citas abiertas. La demanda continuará siendo muy elevada hasta que el suministro sea incrementado, por lo tanto, les pedimos sean pacientes. Las personas deben programar su cita para la segunda vacuna en el momento que reciban la primera.
