Pillars Community Health works to improve the health of our communities and empower individuals through compassionate, whole-person care.

Vision

We envision communities where all people have equal access to the care they need, when they need it.

Healing

Access to quality healthcare and behavioral health services is a critical need among those we serve. 99% of individuals who access our Health Center live in low-income households. Over 27% lack any form of insurance, struggling to afford even nominal fees for services. Hispanic and Latino families, who constitute 57% of our Health Center patient population, experience social and cultural barriers to service, including language barriers and stigmas attached to mental health. Pillars Community Health is dedicated to providing accessible health and social services to ensure that individuals and families receive the care they need when they need it.

Caring

At Pillars Community Health, we strive to improve the health of our community by providing a continuum of services that meet the holistic needs of individuals and families through healthcare, advocacy, and prevention. With services provided on a sliding scale, navigators assist under and uninsured clients and patients with access to care. Medical and legal advocates offer domestic violence and sexual assault survivors crisis intervention. Through a trauma-informed lens, we work to create a safe environment where clients and patients are encouraged to learn about their options for change and empower themselves to make informed decisions about their future.

Educating

Pillars Community Health partners with federal, state, and local health departments to provide guidance and information on all topics related to COVID-19, including vaccines. Our Outreach teams continue to connect with thousands of young people and their caregivers to raise awareness of substance abuse, domestic and sexual violence, and mental health. Just as we have innovated over the past century, we continue to adapt our services to respond to the evolving needs of our local communities.
